briefly, to the list of contributions which may be made to a county or a state employee's account, we add actuarially required contributions under either statute 23-2317 or statute 84-1319, and trustee-to-trustee transfers under statute 23-2323.04 or statute 84-1313.01. "Shall" is changed to "may," regarding developing a schedule of allocation of administrative service agreement costs; and applications for disability retirements would require an application, just as other retirements do, reflected by the amendment item number three. Thank you, and I'd be happy to answer any questions, and urge your support.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Stuhr. Further discussion? Seeing none, the Chair would recognize Senator Stuhr for closing. She waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM0441 to LB 451. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
