SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 143 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to advance LB 143 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced.

CLERK: LB 143A, Mr. President. I have no amendments to the bill, Senator Mossey.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 143A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to advance LB 143A to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 164. I do have E & R amendments, first of all, Senator. (AM7060, Legislative Journal page 614.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 164.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. A little weak there this morning. All opposed? They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend, AM0459. (Legislative Journal page 644.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open on your AM0459 to LB 164.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this amendment is purely technical. The new bill repeated some language that was in current law having to do with the fiscal
