SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...amendment was offered?

SENATOR JENSEN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So it does add something to the bill which was not there before.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And if we look at what he has put into the bill, the definition is limited to the individuals fitting the categories that his amendment establishes. Do you agree with that?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And any person not in one of those categories does not qualify as a relative for purposes of this bill, LB 54. Would you agree?

SENATOR JENSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So are you willing to agree to an amendment that would go into Senator Raikes' amendment saying that sexual orientation shall not disqualify a person from being a relative for purposes of this bill?

SENATOR JENSEN: No, I'm not ready to do that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Why are you not ready?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Chambers. On with discussion. Senator Erdman, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator Chambers, I might be able to address why he's not ready to include this in the bill. Currently, in the
