SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I'm not going to extend the discussion because we are running out of time, and since Senator Erdman and Senator Raikes have reached an agreement, I will vote with them in the way they would like to have the vote taken. SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The motion is to reconsider the vote taken on the Raikes amendment. All in favor of the motion to reconsider vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the motion to reconsider? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 54 to E & R for engrossing.
