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And Senator Janssen, we could maybe give it to one of the other people who were in that room, if you would wish. Shall we give it to Senator Beutler? Senator Beutler, would you like to say anything at this point? Senator Bourne?

SENATOR BOURNE: Sure. Thank you, Senator Schimek, members. I just want to indicate my support for the amendment. I appreciate Senator Janssen and Senator Schimek compromising. And we heard a lot of talk over the debate about, you know, some people wanted it wide open, some people were concerned with the... that it would be too wide open. And so this, I think, is a compromise between those interests. And I just appreciate Senator Schimek and Senator Janssen willingness to work on this issue. So I intend to support the amendment once it comes up, and we'll talk about it more then. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen, Senator Schimek, and Senator Bourne. On with discussion. Senator Schimek, your light is next. Did you wish to use your own time?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: On the amendment, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Smith on committee amendments.

SENATOR SMITH: On the other amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Senator Janssen, there are no further lights on. As Chairman of the committee, you're recognized to close on adoption of committee amendments to LR 11CA.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Just a few minutes here to tell you that we have an amendment following the committee amendments that will change the bill, change the way the committee amendments are. And I ask for your support in opposing the committee amendments that are offered to you now. Please vote red on the committee amendments. Thank you.
