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SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...yes, I'm trying to engage in a continuing dialog with Senator Janssen. Thank you.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Brashear. I am getting about three different messages here and trying to listen to you at the same time. So (inaudible)...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Been there, done that. I understand. So take your time.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Repeat your question, please.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I'm looking at the eight facilities denominated in the amendment. And I'm going to the section preceding, and I'm seeing that we have five existing facil...I think I know, as a matter of record, that there are five existing facilities that are engaged in simulcasting. And simulcasting uses "equipment, or a machine", just to pick two words in the now...new amendment, proposed amendment, AM0656, that raises a question in my mind as to whether we will have five facilities...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...plus three new, or whether we will have eight new facilities to go with the five we already have. And that's...and I'm not saying we can have a one-word answer. I'm trying to raise the issue so that you, Senator Janssen, can address it, and we can make our discussion and intentions a part of the record.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator, can I respond to that?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Absolutely. Please.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The intention is to offer it at those facilities. That would be some of the facilities it could be offered at. If the racetracks, which have this type of gaming
