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SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I would grant my time to Senator Brashear.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. Thank you very much, Senator Schrock. To highlight another issue...and this is not different than what I spoke on several days...I am...I'm just one voice, but I am going to persist with my concern about the word "facilities". Because off the top of my head, it seems to me that that is not a legally specific term, capable of absolute definition, that can be readily and clearly understood without controversy. And if there is to be any controversy about facilities, I will reference again, I was not a member of the body, but I recall reading year after year after year about the branch banking debate. And so we'll call this...my concern is the branch casino issue. I don't know whether a facility is a specific physical structure. I don't know whether a facility is what someone owns through one ownership entity. I don't know whether a facility has to be at one specific and precise geographic location. And I don't know whether one owner who gets one license will ultimately be allowed to have one facility, all bearing the same name, like First National Bank of Nebraska, the same name, and wherever they hang the name and hook it up electronically through machines and equipment, spread wherever, that will be a facility, because it's one person, one entity, that holds one license. And I still keep wondering what these licenses are like. Somebody said we ought to auction these off. And, you know, that might bring a huge amount of revenue. Anyway, I am concerned about the concept of saying eight facilities. Because while I understand the meaning of the word "eight", I don't understand the precise and absolute meaning of the word "facility", particularly "facilities", which is plural. I think these issues...if we are going to have broad enabling legislation and then have the fight here, as I tried to describe the other day, then we can do Senator Janssen's bill. And I'm losing the numbers. But we can do Senator Janssen's original bill, and then we've enabled us, and then we'll just have this
