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decided that was...that could be misinterpreted. You could have several different entities going on the same reservation. If you look at some of the other states guidelines and compacts and so forth, they refer to facility, and it applies to one facility, one building, if you will, and if they...usually in their guidelines, if there is another facility to be authorized by the state, then they have to come back and ask to authorize another facility, that same tribe does. So I'm comfortable with facility. If you can think of any way to make it better, that's fine. I would...I would be open to that, and I'm sure any members of the body would. One of the things I need to say, I guess, and then I'll give my time to you, and I know you want to talk about some other things in the amendment, itself. But we're on General File. We have two more rounds of debate, and I think that we, who signed on to this amendment, are willing to look at the language. I mean we've never been adverse in this body to doing that before. We've got time to work on it if there is some problems. So with that, Senator Brashear, I believe you want to pursue the horse racing aspects of this, and I know what we intended with this legislation, that horse racing tracks could be eligible to become a casino, but they wouldn't necessarily all want to become, and they wouldn't all necessarily be allowed to become, and that you might end up with four free-standing kind of casinos, and then you might end up with three "racinos" as they call them. That was the intention, and if you can help us craft this better, that would be fine. I agree with you. We might have to look at the language before. I'd turn the rest of my time over to you, if you would wish it, Senator.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, thank you, Senator Schimek.

SPEAKER BROMM: You have one minute.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: And I'll answer just quickly. I had turned off my light, actually, because of the hour and where we are, and so...and you may have been out. I mean you're busy, but I had indicated in response to Senator Beutler saying, hey, we can
