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be 30 votes and nothing will go on the ballot. Now I know there is at least 15 drop dead votes in here that won't vote for anything. That's fine. You have your standards and you don't want to do anything, that's fine. But if the other 33 or 34 of us don't get our act together and start compromising, nothing is going to happen, and that's fine with me. Let's just let the paid petitioners do it. Let's end up...we'll end up with slot machines in our bars and our bowling alleys and our VFW clubs. And that's not what I envision for this state. That's not what Iowa is doing. I wished Iowa would have done nothing, but we've got five casinos on our border, just on the Iowa side, and all you have to do in Missouri is go to St. Joe and Kansas City and they have them. And there's, like I said there's four...I passed out the map, take a look at it. There is 10 casinos in South Dakota, three of them on our border. So if you want to have it your way, go to Burger King. But you can't have it your way here, and I think we are doomed to fail if we say let's have it our way. It's not going to happen.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion, Senator Jensen, followed by six others.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, and members of the Legislature. The first time I spoke on this bill, I mentioned that we should take a look at some dollars and we should follow the money. It's interesting, the debate, I haven't heard anything about that since we started. And as a matter of fact, the letters that I got last year were all concerned about the dollars. I don't get any e-mails from any of my constituents saying we've got to have gambling for the dollars, and I am not hearing it in the body here that we've got to have gambling for the dollars. But as far as I'm concerned, unless the state can make something out of this, unless we can generate some income out of this, why? Why would we go into this? Just because a few people want it, want to gamble. Well, hey, we have cards. We have bingo. We have many other...we have slots, or not slot machines, but we certainly have pickle cards. We have keno. We've already got that. And so if we're going to go into this, I think we need to look at the...if we're going to generate any dollars out of this. And I haven't heard that we are, and on
