SENATOR JANSSEN: ...we know better?. Thank you, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I'd call the question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on AM0656? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. Senator Janssen, you're recognized to close on your amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, and I do plan on sharing some of my time with Senator Schimek on this. We've had some good debate this morning. And, my, doesn't this body get quiet. This is a big decision you're going to have to make. You're going to have to go back to your constituents and say I didn't know why I didn't support that. I guess...I guess maybe we better let the people behind the glass door deciding for us. I guess maybe we'd better let a petition get out there and make our decision for us. This is a compr...this amendment is a compromise. This amendment still allows this Legislature to decide how many. I would rather have it that the Legislature decide the whole thing, how many. This allows us to decide whether we want up to eight facilities in this state. That doesn't mean that we're going to have eight, immediate thing like that. That's for you to decide in this body, and this is the best chance you're probably going to get. So when you push that button red or green or answer yes or no, I want you to think of what could happen, and it's steamrolling right now. Let me tell you those petition supporters are working hard. They're working hard, and if we don't...and the court, I think, is sitting back waiting to see what we do. It's time to...it's time for you to be accountable to your constituents. I'll give
