SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Vrtiska, to open.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I would move for the introduction of LB 806 and LB 807, which are the claims bills that will be in committee in another week. With that, thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Open for discussion, that motion. Senator Tyson, your light was on, did you mean for that to be for this or...it is now off. No other discussion. Senator Vrtiska, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR VRTISKA: I waive closing except to remind that it takes 30 votes. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It does require 30 votes. You've heard the motion. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to allow for introduction of two new bills, Mr. President.
