CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 732.) 39 ayes,
0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to approve the confirmation
report.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is successful. Next item on the
agenda, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Combs would move to withdraw
LR 40.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Combs.

SENATOR COMBS: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I make a
motion to withdraw, by unanimous consent, LR 40 due to drafting
error.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schimek, is your light on for this
purpose? Okay. Thank you. Members, the question before us is
the withdrawal of LR 40. All in favor please vote aye, opposed
nay. Please record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the withdrawal of
LR 40.

SPEAKER BROMM: LR 40 is withdrawn. We'll go to the next item,
Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 11, by Senator Janssen. It's a
constitutional amendment to Article III, Section 24, of the
Constitution of Nebraska. The resolution has been discussed.
As of yesterday, there was an amendment to this resolution
offered by Senator Janssen and others, AM0656, that was adopted.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Janssen, before we proceed into general
debate on the bill, would you bring the body up to date on where
we are following yesterday.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the
Legislature, I want to start off by thanking everyone who voted
for the amendment yesterday. That shows a little faith that
possibly we are going to be able to come to a compromise with
