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forever.

SPEAKER BROMM. Time.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Schrock. Oh, I'm sorry. Excuse me,
Senator Schrock. Mr. Clerk, do you have an amendment?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Senator Beutler would move to
amend, AM0675. (Legislative Journal page 733.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler to open on the amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this
is a technical amendment. You may recall that early yesterday
Senator Brashear brought up the question of whether the eight
new locations that were authorized under this subsection,
whether we would include in that the horse racing locations that
already exist. And he was saying, because the definition of
gaming is broad and includes some things that they do at
existing horse racing sites, would those be included so that
effectively there would just be three more locations or four
more locations? And we responded that this was one of the
technical things that needs to be worked out between the new
section and the other sections of the constitutional provision.
So this one, just to illustrate to you how these things can be
worked out, very simply works out this problem. What it says is
that the Legislature may authorize gaming at up to eight
facilities in the state of Nebraska under this subsection, so
that means it's eight and you don't count any preexisting horse
tracks, horse racing tracks as part of that eight. That's all
the amendment does, as simple as that. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I give my time to Senator Schimek.
