SPEAKER BROMM PRESIDING

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Members, please report to the floor and record your presence. Senators Jones, Cudaback, and Burling, and Quandahl, McDonald, Cunningham, Connealy, and Aguilar. Senator Quandahl, Senator Connealy, Senator Aguilar. Senator Smith, your options are call-in votes or roll call.

SENATOR SMITH: Call-in is sufficient.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Smith, we're missing Senator Quandahl and Senator Connealy and Senator Aguilar. Do you want to proceed, or do you wish to wait?

SENATOR SMITH: I'd ask for a record vote as well.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay.

SENATOR SMITH: To call the question.

SPEAKER BROMM: Call-in votes have been authorized, members who haven't voted.

CLERK: Senator Landis voting yes. Senator Jones...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler.
