PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Mossey. You've heard the motion. The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President,...

CLERK: Excuse me, Mr. President. Senator Byars would move to amend with AM0540. (Legislative Journal page 710.)
