March 6, 2003            LB 131, 175

SENATOR MOSSEY:     Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 175.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Mossey. The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor please say aye. Those opposed nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK:     Mr. President, Senator Jensen would move to amend with AM0521. (Legislative Journal page 710.)

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Jensen, to open on his amendment.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members of the Legislature. This is a minor clean-up amendment. Earlier this year, we have passed from this body LB 131, which is before the Governor to be signed, and that eliminated all references to industrial loan and investment companies. LB 175 does have one of those references. And this amendment is needed to remove that reference to an industrial loan and investment company from LB 175, to comply with the changes in LB 131. That's all it does. I'd ask for its adoption. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Further discussion? Seeing none, the Chair would recognize Senator Jensen for closing. He waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM0521 to LB 175. All those in favor please vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:     32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT HEINEMAN: The Chair would recognize Senator Mossey.
