CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Thank you. Your Committee on Natural Resources reports LB 348 to General File with amendments attached; LB 739, General File with amendments attached; LB 748 indefinitely postponed; LB 779 indefinitely postponed. General Affairs Committee reports LB 367 General File; LB 393 indefinitely postponed. Government Committee reports LB 437 to General File with amendments; LB 310 indefinitely postponed; LB 463, and LB 582, LB 584 indefinitely postponed as well. And the Revenue Committee reports LB 80, LB 109, LB 163, LB 193, LB 284, LB 398, LB 399, LB 519, LB 520, LB 543, LB 577, LB 578, LB 635, LB 642, LB 649, LB 677, LB 728, LB 734, LB 749, LB 769, LB 774, all of those reported indefinitely postponed. SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next item or amendment on the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler had printed AM0698. Senator, I understand you want to withdraw?

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend with AM0743. (Legislative Journal page 775.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Bromm, members of the Legislature, I think the question before you today is whether you want to make the student more of an athlete or whether you want to make the athlete more of a student. Because the problem that has been identified by Senator Chambers can be dealt with in two different ways. Senator Chambers says, recognize where they are in this system, and pay them more. My amendment would say, recognize where they are in the system, but require less time of them, so that they can go out and work, so that they can participate in the cultural and intellectual life of the university, and so they can have adequate time for academics, to
