SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There is not a great amount of interest in academics. What Senator Beutler is doing is putting another facet to this discussion. And I think it is valid. But if it's in the context of enacted legislation, it will pay attention, presidents will pay attention, and we will begin to get some changes.
