SENATOR BEUTLER: Did you vote to kill it?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes, I did.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Oh. And you have one more bill on livestock fees, right?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes. And when we...and it's...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Are you going to vote to kill that one too?

SENATOR SCHROCK: No.

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Our intention is for an interim study. And keep in mind,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, why...

SENATOR SCHROCK: ...these bills were brought to me by Department of Environmental Quality, at least the concepts of them. I said, well, let's introduce two bills and look at two different ways of funding our livestock waste management situation. And so we introduced two bills. DEQ came in; of course, supported both bills. And of course, all the farm organizations, ag organizations, livestock organizations came in and testified against it.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, we can all understand why they would testify against it. And I don't want to get off on the livestock bills, because they're peripheral to this. But is...you know, you indicated that the water fee bill should have an interim study, and so should the livestock fees. Is that going to be the same interim study?

SENATOR SCHROCK: No.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Different interim studies.
