to transfer water, so I think that's important to have in the bill. And then there's some other issues that are important for the bill, too. But I think the main thing that brought this all about was somebody wanted to try to drill wells, you know, and transfer water, and so I think this kind of puts a conclusion to that and hopefully we can continue to move this on to Select and Final Reading. So again, just appreciate your vote to move LB 619 on forward. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. You heard the closing on the advancement of LB 619. The question is whether LB 619 should advance to E & R Initial. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the advancement of LB 619 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 619.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 619 does advance. Mr. Clerk, any message, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on General Affairs reports LB 471 as indefinitely postponed. Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee reports LB 156, General File with amendments. Judiciary Committee reports LB 354, LB 364, LB 610 to General File; LB 118, LB 133, LB 455, LB 628, and LB 629 to General File with committee amendments attached; all those reports signed by their respective committee Chairs. New resolution, LR 46, by Senator Engel; that will be laid over. An Agriculture Committee confirmation report signed by Senator Kremer, as Chair of the committee; a briefing notice from the Retirement Systems Committee; and Senator Schimek has an amendment to LB 437 to be printed. SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: LB 294, a bill by Senator Foley and others. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, at that
