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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I support the amendment, I support the bill. I'm pleased that Senator McDonald brought this. Rick and I had not that long to get to know each other, but I respected him tremendously. And I think this is one of the greatest tributes that could be paid to a person. And, Senator McDonald, I am very pleased that you give me the opportunity to support a bill like this.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Combs, on the amendment.

SENATOR COMBS: Senator Cudaback, members of the body, being a former home health and hospice nurse for six years, I want to say that I wholeheartedly support the amendment and the bill and the spirit behind the bill, and not only from the standpoint of being a nurse, but of also taking care of many, many patients, who this is a tribute to, that would be very pleased to know that other patients are going to benefit from what they are leaving behind. Certainly people leave a legacy far more when they pass away from cancer than just their drugs. But I know the many patients I've taken care of would be so pleased to know that this kind of legislation is going into place. I commend Vickie and all the other people that is on the bill. If your name isn't on the bill, I'd like you to get on it, because I think that would send a strong message to the families that are grieving, the patients themselves that are on hospice right now. So I wholeheartedly support this, I thank Vickie for bringing it, and I ask for everyone else's support also. Turn my time back to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Combs. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Mr. President, members of the body, I also want to very strongly support these amendments and this bill. There's kind of two things that come to mind this morning. One is, some of you might wonder about the actual mechanics of this. I see where there would be no problems at all in working with the physicians' offices. They do this type of thing a little bit already with the samples that they get from the various pharmaceutical companies, and do it very well.
