CLERK: 37 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SPEAKER BROMM: The reading is dispensed with. We will read LB 157 by title, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 157.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 157 pass? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 878.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 157 passes. LB 158E. Members, the first vote would be whether to suspend the at-large reading. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SPEAKER BROMM: The at-large reading is dispensed with. Please read LB 158E by title, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 158.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 158E pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 879.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 158E does pass with the emergency clause
