SPEAKER BROMM: LB 194 passes. LB 195.

CLERK: (Read LB 195 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 195 pass? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 884-885.)  
46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present not voting, 1 excused and not voting,  
Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 195 passes. Members, LB 199, and the first vote will be a vote to suspend the at-large reading. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SPEAKER BROMM: The reading is dispensed with. Please read the bill by title, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read title of LB 199.)

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 199 pass? All in favor please vote aye, and opposed no. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 885-886.)  
46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present not voting, 1 excused and not voting,  
Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 199 passes. LB 205. Just...just, before...excuse me, Mr. Clerk. I apologize. (Visitors introduced.) Thank you. Please proceed, Mr. Clerk. LB 205.
