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order on the revocation of the license when one is stopped and is over the limit on the test. Just to quickly remind the body, this bill was developed out of a task force that met last summer in an effort to fix the problems with the ALR laws that existed. As you'll hear in further discussion, we have claims being filed by county attorneys for handling this. We have a considerable amount, I think, of inconsistency in how it's handled throughout the state, and it probably is not a very pretty system right now. So this bill is an effort to try and clean that up and I know there's at least one amendment filed and we'll proceed with debate. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the review on the bill and we are... now we'll go to discussio.. of the bill itself, LB 209. Senator Vrtiska, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. I only wanted to report that the claims that have been brought to the Business and Labor Committee amount to \$38,000, ver \$38,000 to pay this year from claims to county attorneys. And I have a complete list, if anybody would like to see it, of those claims that are out there that are being submitted that our committee is going to have to talk about this afternoon when they meet. B't I thought it would be interesting for the body to know that we have, from county attorneys across the state, 38,000-plus dollars that are being requested to be paid to attorneys for processing these ALR claims. With that, Mr. Chairman, I'll turn the Chair back to you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Senator Chambers, on advancement of LB 209.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I have not favored the administrative license revocation program from the outset. I objected to it when it was being put in place. I voted against it. Since we always have to state some things for the record so that it's clear what our position is on drunk driving, let me say this about that.
