Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I would yield my time to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, we need to see this bill for what it is. There is a group that takes a very hard-nosed attitude towards anybody who drinks. They can do that, and they have a right, if they can trick enough senators in a committee to have a bad bill like this put before us, but I don't have to knuckle under, roll over and accept it as though it's fair, fitting and proper. I think it is not, and I'm going to fight this bill until the cows stagger home, till they stagger home, not because they are inebriated from imbibing of alcoholic beverages, but because they are plain worn out. If people don't want to take a lot of time on these kind of bills, they should not bring them. There are other provisions in the bill that I dislike, and I'm offering amendments so that they can be given a thorough airing. This is the kind of bill which people automatically vote for because it sounds good on its face. You're taking drunk drivers off the streets. What I see us doing is skewing the system. It is perverting the system to pander to one lobbying special interest group. And others may be intimidated to oppose what they're doing because the argument will be made, well, you're in favor of drunk driving. Just like President Bush says if you don't want to pass another resolution at the UN saying war is not the thing, then what you're really doing is saying you approve of Saddam Hussein and everything he stands for. Well, that is not what these other countries approve of. That is not what they are voting on. But when people are so weak-minded that they allow somebody to skew the argument and brand them a certain way, if they stand up for their position, then that is their problem when they allow that to be done to them. I don't care how I am characterized. I don't care who may be offended. This legislation offends me. So when they bring it here, they need to expect me to fight it tooth and nail by means of every stratagem under the rules at my disposal.
