SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I just want to stand up and make a few comments on this bill. Because in my area where I live, well, there...every time I go there, you don't bring up the subject of LB 775. So there's a lot of opposition in my area on it. But what I'm saying is, I'm glad we're coming back to visit it now. And maybe we can make some adjustments on it so it will work. And I'm going to stand up and support LB 620 and LB 270, taking them out. Because, I don't know, it's sure hard to figure out who is actually using LB 270 out in my area. And then once in a while you'll get somebody that they have used it. But what I think we need to do is vote in the amendment that's coming that will give something out there. Because I don't want to take away these two and not have nothing in return, because we need economic development in the worst way out there. And so another thing I wanted to talk about a little bit is, it's...Advantage Receivable came out to Ainsworth and started up a business, and they had 60 employees. And these 60 employees was really...work ethics was above and beyond. Because the day we went up there for the annual dedication on it, there was a snowstorm there, and people stayed in overnight and rented motel rooms so they could be there the next morning. But within a year after that, they'd left town. And I think they went down to Bellevue or someplace. But I'm just wondering whether they went...whether they was getting LB 775 advantage up there I never did find out, and whether they went and started another business down in Bellevue and do it again, I don't know. I'd kind of like to have the answers on that. I'd like to ask Senator Hartnett a question on that.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR JONES: Yes. On the Advantage Receivable, did they come to Bellevue, or do you know about them, or...?

SENATOR HARTNETT: What's that, LB 775?

SENATOR JONES: Yes.
