SENATOR LANDIS: I'm sorry. Do it again?

SENATOR BROWN: What is the number that you would say we would...?

SENATOR LANDIS: In the last year, about four and a half million dollars were...could have been taken, but there were credits for, I think, three and a half million dollars. So under that context, I think you're looking at add-back of roughly \$3 million into the pot of savings that you could then use for a far more productive form of expenditure. And I would name two: "microenterprise" has a darn good track record, and job training has a darn good track record.

SPEAKER BROMM: Time.

SENATOR BROWN: Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Brashear would move to amend the committee amendment, FA1204. Senator Brashear, I have in front of me your AM0880. (Legislative Journal page 948.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, this is the amendment that Senator Landis mentioned earlier. It's available to you on your viewers. It is...this is not a significant amendment, except that it clarifies and makes certain what we are doing in this first division which we have denoted as "the rest" of the bill. In fact, if you have your white copy of the amendment before...of the committee amendment before you, I can show you that we are using language which exactly comes from page 31 of the committee amendment, beginning at line 14 and ending at line 17. We are simply reiterating that language by inserting it on page 32, at subpart (4), just above Section 11, lines 4 through 6. And this has the effect...this has nothing to do with LB 270. This has to do with those portions of the FA1204 which are repealing LB 775 benefits. And this amendment
