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FLOOR DEBATE

March 18, 2003      LB 608

Maxwell.      I do see five hands.      The question then is, shall debate cease?      All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      26 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Debate is ceased.      Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close on your amendment.

SENATOR BRASHEAR:      Mr Speaker, members of the body, I urge the adoption of the amendment.      As I stated earlier, and want to make clear, this is a clarification as it relates to the LB 775 portions of the bill only. Does not relate to LB 270, because it specifically includes by its terms the concept of an application, and makes certain that those portions which we repeal in this division we call "the rest" of the bill will be repealed prospectively only, and that pending applications filed prior to the effective date will have the benefit of the law as it exists now before amendment.      I urge the adoption of the amendment.      Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Thank you, Senator Brashear.      You've heard the closing.      The question before us is the adoption of AM0880 to FA1204.      All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay.      Please record.

CLERK:      33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Brashear's amendment to the committee amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM:      The amendment is adopted.      We're still on FA1204.      Do we have anything else on this section of the bill, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK:      I have nothing further on this component, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM:      I see no further lights.      Senator Landis, you're recognized to close on this component of LB 608.

SENATOR LANDIS:      Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature.      Ahead of us we have issues on disclosure, the meat packing industry, the setting of wages as minimums for LB 775
