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knowledge of Game and Parks, and certainly would support this nomination.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Byars. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President, members of the body, I just want to stand in strong support for Bill Zutavern. He's been a strong supporter of mine, and also, I've known him ever since I've been in the Legislature. But he'd be a strong supporter for the Sandhill area, and I think we really need something...body like that in the Sandhills, because he's been a rancher up there all his life. And I think he'd do us a lot of good on the Game and Parks Commission, because a lot of our resources is in the Sandhills, and I think that's good to have somebody that's right in there and has lived his whole life there. So I give strong support for Mr. Zutavern. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Erdman on the confirmation report.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature. I was wondering if Senator Schrock would yield to a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, will you yield to a question from Senator Erdman?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Senator Schrock, would you explain to me...I heard your opening about the reappointment of Mr. Stuart, and I'm not questioning his ability. I'm questioning how that is being allowed to happen. Could you explain that a little further?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Erdman, as I recall...and I'm not 100 percent positive of this...James Stuart was serving on the commission and represented the district that Mark Pinkerton is now going to represent. So Mark Pinkerton was appointed to Mr. Stuart's district. The new district was Lancaster County. And so James Stuart was appointed to fill a five-year term
