revised. It's just as necessary to revisit that model and not accept it as the law of the Medes and the Persians as it is to revisit LB 775 and update it. There are obvious flaws in the model that I won't consume your time to discuss.

SPEAKER BROMM: Will the model as it exists and as you understand it be able to be utilized, with the committee amendment?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I don't know why not. Because the committee amendment would provide any and all information.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: So of course you could run the model...

SPEAKER BROMM: And will the model...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: ...using the information.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...will the model as we know it to be, be able to be utilized with your amendment?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes.
