category now. We're disclosing all kinds of specific company information to the public. If we now start doing project by project analysis on a county by county basis, and we're already disclosing company-specific information to anyone and everyone, what is it that the Legislative Fiscal Office will do with the project by project, county by county specificity, while preserving confidentiality appropriate in the marketplace? How does it get done? The committee amendment doesn't tell us how. Doesn't give us a clue. Are we going to litigate that? Is it going to be just the members of the Revenue Committee that get the project by project, county by county specificity? Or is it going to be any and all members of the Legislature, but nobody should reveal anything they shouldn't, but they should reveal everything they're required to by law, and if they reveal something wrong, there's a criminal penalty? I'm sorry. This isn't written so that it works down to the final conclusion. And the way to push back is to try and preserve the desire of the Revenue Committee for more specificity, to add to it the specificity which was a part of the gubernatorial initiative, but not allow the...what I'll call loose transfer now of everything from the Department of Revenue to the Legislative Fiscal Office, and hope we can find the answers later. I urge us to adopt AM0879. We will be moving forward. We will be preserving the credible, technical, specific work product of the committee. But we won't be blinking, blinking and pretending not to notice...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR BPASHEAR: ...the things that we do not have answers for. I urge the adoption of AM0879. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the closing, members. The question before us is the adoption of AM0879 to FA1205. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
