Revenue, fair enough. That's out, and I'll be happy to honor that by not trying to adjust that on Select File or wherever. But I would say this; that if that was the message, I think you've won the day. However, this amendment goes further and it essentially offers up information that we didn't ask for and that we don't care necessarily to learn. It doesn't move us forward. I would say this. There is a political downside to adopting this amendment, but it may be exactly what you want to have happen. It will allow the business community to say, you know what, we stepped forward and did disclosure. It's not disclosure that we wanted to use. It's not disclosure we wanted. It's not disclosure that moves us forward in our analysis, but they will be able to say that they offered up disclosure and that's just not good enough. You know what? Keeping things as they are is at least truthful and honest, and on that basis I'd ask that you not adopt this portion of the committee amendment, because it's no longer the committee amendment. It's something else completely. I will be instructed by what you've done. I won't go back and try to put back in what you've told me you don't want there. I acknowledge that. But I bet you don't know the provisions that you are adopting affirmatively if you vote for this amendment. I actually think that we'd be as well off and we'd be as authentic as we can be at this juncture by simply not adopting this. Now, since this language is not mine, I think I ought to yield the last of my time, which institutionally I get to do because I'm the committee Chair, to in fact the proponent of the language. So I offer whatever time I have remainder for sort of a point/counterpoint to Senator Brashear, so if he wanted to make a comment in defense of the language he could.
