SPEAKER BROMM: Time. Thank you, Senator Brashear. The question before us is the adoption of the FA1205 component of the committee amendment. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 17 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendment FA1205.

SPEAKER BROMM: FA1205 is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item on the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, the next component of the committee amendments, FA1206. Again, if I may characterize by Senator Landis' handout is the slaughterhouses section, I believe. (Legislative Journal page 996.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on FA1206.

SENATOR LANDIS: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this amendment paints with a broad brush, but it says that slaughterhouse operations are not available for LB 775 benefits. It paints with a broad brush because LB 775 gives with a broad brush. You can despoil our natural resources and be guilty of major environmental violations and get tax credits. You can not pay your employees what you promised them, juggle the books, not give them their overtime and still get LB 775 credits. You can conspire to bring in illegal aliens or undocumented workers to fill these jobs, commit a crime in doing so, and still get LB 775 benefits. You can have unsafe working conditions which violate OSHA laws and produce a high amount of worker employee injury and get LB 775 benefits. You can bust a union and have violations of the National Labor Relations Board Act and get LB 775 benefits. And while that rarely happens, it happens with
