SENATOR CUDABACK:      You still have one minute left, Senator Brashear, if you care to use it. Senator Bromm, followed by Senator Landis, Erdman, Wehrbein, and Combs. Senator Bromm, on your amendment to FA1206 to LB 608, third component of the divided question.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Thank you, Mr. President, and I don't think I need all this time. In fact, when I put my light on I was thinking about calling the question, but there are a number of lights and I don't want to...if somebody has something to say, I want them to have the opportunity to do that. But maybe I would ask a couple of questions of Senator Landis, if he would be amenable to a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK:      Senator Landis, are you available for a question?

SENATOR LANDIS:      Sure.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Senator Landis, we've had a considerable amount of discussion here for an hour and a half or so, and I wondered if you, at this point, had any position with respect to the amendment that I have proposed, and if...

SENATOR LANDIS:      Yes, I do.

SPEAKER BROMM:      ...so, I know you have your light on, but you'd be welcome to use some of this time, if you'd like.

SENATOR LANDIS:      Happy to tell you, I am going to vote for your amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Okay, thank you. I think...I want to emphasize again, I know the amendment needs work. There may be some areas that are left out of the amendment that should be included, and there may be some due process concerns. There may be some definitions that need to be elaborated on, but I think that we need time to do that. And I would not want to put the final touches on it on General File but rather work on it more at a later time. So with that, I'll yield the rest of my time back
