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Legislature and win? Everybody stands and beats his or her breast and cries mea culpa, mea culpa, but I'm going to do what the exploiters want me to do, but I want you people who are out there being valued less than others to know that I'm not happy doing this to you, but I got to do it to you because the business people told me I've got to do it and I bow to them. Morality means nothing. There are people on this floor who will talk about morality on other issues, but when it comes down to literally the bread and butter issue, meaning food on the table, morality takes wings and flies out the window. There is no talk by my Catholic friends about social justice. Now, that's something they were big on at Creighton. In all of the so-called philosophy classes, social justice was a big issue. I read Catholic publications, believe it or not. I have to know what the enemy is saying. (Laugh) Social justice is something they talk about whether they're Franciscans, Jesuits, or whoever, and social justice has to do with society determining that certain things are not going to be allowed to happen to its members who are not in a position to protect themselves and that which they and their family ought to have.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There are people who will quote the Bible when they say the hand...the sword of vengeance is in the hands of the state, to justify the death penalty, but they don't want to quote the Bible about being good stewards so that we make sure that the poor are provided for. It's very selective. And when morality becomes relative, then it is immorality. I don't claim religion or any of that kind of thing, but I use it to flay my colleagues with because they profess to believe in it and pray about it every morning. Thank you, Madam President.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Landis, there are no further lights. You are recognized to close on your amendment.
