areas the threshold would be \$8.70, no health insurance reference at all. In counties of 20,000 or less it would \$8.25. In the urban counties we would be using the workers' comp index; in the other counties the design is to use 75 percent of the annual state wage, but it was written in a different way so which means that we're going to need to do some drafting on Select File to comport with this. But those, conceptually, are the pieces. This is my offer to you, is to say is this a livable middle ground that we can jointly accept between two relatively disparate camps. It's my offer to you rather than the lobby. We'll see what the outcome is. Thank you.
