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this is my time to vent and it's a bill about which I will speak, but I will not have any guilty role to play in moving it across the board. Some people feel that if the bill moved, there will be another day when a battle can be waged on these very same issues. I hope they are telling the truth, but I will not vote for the bill in its present form, and I will not vote for this committee amendment, but I'm just one vote. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator. You may continue Senator Chambers, your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I would ask somebody who knows what is in this bill what is in it, but I'm not going to waste the body's time. There is nothing they can mention about this bill which is a positive good. They might say, well, we started at point A and this bill, when we started out, was to move us to point B, which is ten yards away from point A. Well, although the present form of the bill moves us only one centimeter toward point B, that one centimeter is farther along than we would be without the bill. But some differences are so inconsequential that they make no difference. Not every change or modification is an improvement. What will be made better if this bill, in its present form, should the committee amendment be adopted, what will be made better by this bill? All it will do is strengthen the business lobby, persuade them they run this Legislature, that nobody is going to stand up to them. They shake their fist and rattle that door back there, and everybody knuckles under. They put up the white flag of surrender and wave it. You know what we have the opportunity to do on these bills, "Brother" Mines? I didn't say brother of mine, I said "Brother" Mines. We can pin on our chest the red badge of courage or you can stick in your lapel the white feather of cowardice. So which will it be? I and the business community already know. We know you. We understand you. But they're trying to take advantage of you and keep you where they know you are, and I'm trying to raise you into stars of manhood and womanhood. And who will win? The business community, of course. I know it. You know it. I would never conduct myself in such a way that somebody could talk about me like this, and I'd just have to sit there and swallow spit because they're
