SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...his tie all twisted. (inaudible), I meant they have everything; they could have stepped out of GQ magazine. Their shoes are shined, wingtip. They've got argyle socks, which if they raise the cuff of their britches, will the socks match the britches? But I, who am representing the people who look like I look; not blue collar, no collar, hardworking people, hard callused hands, who have no voice, those are the ones that I identify with. And we lose, we lose, we lose yet again, but we will not quit. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion on FA1207? Seeing none, Senator Landis, do you wish to close on FA1207?

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. This has the standards for wages in them. It was what we did just before the noonhour or, actually, after the immediate aftermath of the noonhour, and I would ask for the adoption of this part of the committee amendment as it has been amended on the floor.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The question before the body is FA1207, offered by the Revenue Committee, which is the fourth component of the divided committee amendments to LB 608. All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the fourth component of the divided committee amendments offered by the Revenue Committee to LB 608. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 4 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendment, FA1207.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment was adopted. Mr. Clerk, next component.
