in the problems with the bill that we had before us then, he identified the problem of the wage scale as the most critical reason for its failure to succeed in jobs. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Landis. Senator Jones.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President and members of the body, I just listened to this and I missed out on some of it this morning, but I've got some counties that it takes six or eight of them, maybe more, to even get to the number there. So it's going to cover a wider area in my area just to be able to do something. But, anyway, I'm a lot more in favor of Senator Bromm's amendment than I am of the one that's up here. But I think we're going to be able to talk about that later, but I do have a question for Senator Bromm.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm, will you respond to a question from Senator Jones?

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes, yes.

SENATOR JONES: Am I understanding right that you cannot start a business and have...and sell retail?

SPEAKER BROMM: And get the tax incentive...

SENATOR JONES: Get the tax...

SPEAKER BROMM: ...program under this bill?

SENATOR JONES: ...incentive. Well, I was thinking about a man that wanted to start a welding shop to make, you know, wagons or whatever, you know, and he sells them out to farmers. Now, he cannot...that won't work then?

SPEAKER BROMM: I think that would be manufacturing. I think that would be...

SENATOR JONES: Okay.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...eligible.
