Legislature, Senator Chambers, you're probably right but I like to get back at thinking, what is the difference between a retailer and a wholesaler? In some cases, they are the same darn one. You know, I'm not an ardent fan of Wal-Mart. I've read a couple of books on Wal-Mart and see what they are doing to every state that they've moved into. So if they can be the world's largest retailer and still qualify for LB 775 dollars, somewhere that just doesn't sit right with me. I think it's wrong. So it's for a distribution center, so what? They are still the world's largest retailer and we're not supposed to be giving LB 775 credit to retailers. So where do you draw the line? It's...I have a small grocery store. Senator Cunningham has a small grocery store. So what if we would want to invest \$1 million in a small town, hire ten employees and use those in between the retail outlets. That's what the largest company in the world is doing, besides killing all the small businesses on main street in Nebraska and Missouri and Iowa and Wyoming. You just name them. That's what's happening. So I cannot see why Senator Cunningham or I couldn't go down the street and invest \$1 million in a building and use those...use employees from our own company, paying them the \$8.25 an hour, whatever it is, what's the difference? It just seems to me that the big boy gets away with it and the little guy is going to get it stuck right in his ear. With that, I'd give the rest of my time to Senator Cunningham. I think I got him fired up a little bit.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Cunningham, you have about two and a half minutes.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. I guess I agree with Senator Janssen, but the only thing I wanted to stand up and tell him, the main reason that that wouldn't work for you and I, especially if I were a partner, I don't have \$1 million. Thank you.
