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SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...you probably will not get anybody to bite. But if you do, you have somebody investing enough money to have the possibility of succeeding. Now I don't know what business he or she would try to bring into a community where there are only 20,000 people in the entire county, but there may be such a business. The amount should not be lowered below \$3 million. I don't think it will work with that. But since it's not going to work with that, you shouldn't have it as high as \$1 million. Make it \$500,000 and two jobs, because it ain't going to work no matter what you do. I'm not going to vote for this bill, but I'm not going to sit it out this time. I'm going to vote no because it violates and offends my principles to vote in favor of something, which in the form it's being voted on cannot deliver...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...what the public will be made to believe that it's delivering. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kremer, Senator Chambers, I'm sorry. Senator Kremer's light is next. I'm sorry, Senator Chambers. Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Okay, thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. Senator Chambers, I was just going to maybe list a few things that could take place out in rural Nebraska, but before that you was asking how much money you'd have to invest in a livestock operation or farming operation. It would depend on how many years you wanted to go before you run out of money. If you went ten years, you'd have to have some; in 20 years, it'd be twice that much you have to invest. But several things in our area that would qualify, and some of them...we have a dog food factory that employs over 200 people. That did qualify for LB 775 but it could be on a smaller scale. We have a computer programming company that employs about 25 to 30 people writing programs for grocery stores in the checkout. We have...there was a company that was going to come in that was going to manufacture camping supplies, which actually went somewhere else. We have a facility that manufactures equipment for
