SENATOR CHAMBERS:      ...that that bill has only one subject, is that your belief?

SENATOR JENSEN:      I cannot say that, no.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:      So you do see where there may very well be more than one subject.

SENATOR JENSEN:      I understand that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:      Would you want to lose...so here's what you should look at. Which parts of the bill do you want to lose, because I believe the whole bill will be struck down if you add all these parts. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Thank you, Senator Chambers. We're still on the committee amendments. I see no further lights. Senator Jensen, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR JENSEN:      I'll waive closing.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Senator Jensen waives closing, and the question before the body is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 667. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Record.

CLERK:      32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM:      The amendments are adopted. The next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      Mr. President, Senator Jensen would offer AM0821. And pursuant to that offering, Senator Jensen would move to suspend Rule 7, Section 3(d), to permit consideration of AM0821 as an amendment to LB 667.

SPEAKER BROMM:      Senator Jensen, you're recognized to open on the motion to suspend the rules.
