SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of committee amendments, AM0770, to the bill. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BROMM: The committee amendments are adopted. Any further discussion on the bill? Seeing none, Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close on the advancement of LB 46 to E & R Initial.
