SENATOR BROWN: I would like a call of the house, please.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brown has requested a call of the house. All in favor of a call of the house vote aye, and opposed nay.

SENATOR BROWN: Curt? (Laugh) Sorry.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. Speaker, I'd like a roll call vote in regular order, please.

SPEAKER BROMM: A roll call vote in regular order has been requested. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please return to your seats and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. We are under call. Senator Johnson, Senator Hartnett. Senator Hartnett, we are under call. Would you return to the Chamber. You may proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1041.) 24 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: The bill does not advance. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, amendments to be printed: Senator Beutler, LB 165; Senator Bromm, LB 524; Senator Schrock, LB 619. (Also an amendment by Senator Schrock to LB 479.)
