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to happen. And, furthermore, it delays the financing issues and leaves people hanging in the lurch out there trying to raise the money. So I oppose this bracket motion, but do agree to divide the question if that's what the body wants to do, but I also would like to leave the checkoff at one cent and move the bill to Select File, and we'd work on it between now and then. I think that's reasonable. If we only need three-quarters of a cent come May 1, that's fine. I don't want to pile up money. I'm contributing to this like everyone else that grows corn. Let's do that. So with that, I'd return the rest of my time to the Speaker. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Baker. Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. I guess this kind of is getting kind of confusing and complicated, but I would be in opposition to the bracket motion by Senator Chambers. Then divide the question; take up the checkoff part, Section 7, by itself; look at the rest of the bill with the clean-up parts there that we kind of need to do. Several of them could wait without any problem. There's a couple issues that need to be taken before that. So at this time I would oppose the bracket motion. Thank you. I'd give the balance of my time back to the Chair.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Kremer. Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Speaker and members, I guess on this everybody wants to make their point. I was reluctant to vote for the bracket motion, for the original bracket motion, because that would not have...it would have killed this bill, essentially. And I think this is a good bill. It's a good bill. It's a good bill if you need it. And I support Senator Baker's bill. If you need it, it's a reserve. It's like having a savings account. If you need it, why, you're there. And I do support it, if you need it. I guess if the Speaker says that he would bring this bill back up on May 1, he would give us that, you know, try to do this and it'd go through the process, it can be done in that month's time. So I think that timing is everything and I believe in the system. I think it could happen that way. If we need this bill, we should have it, but I think
