SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Hartnett, followed by Senators Bromm and Dwite Pedersen. Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Dwite Pedersen, could I ask you a question? I...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Pedersen, would you respond to a question from Senator Hartnett?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Yes, Mr. President.

SENATOR HARTNETT: My question is that I think when you talked the first time, or talked on this bill the first time, is that you talked about...you said if...at the third time...you saw the third time as the time driving under influence is the really...I'm a...if I do that and I'm the four time, that's bad. Is that right? Bad, bad, bad?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: The statute already says...the statutes already say that after the third offense, a fourth offense is a felony. That I agree with. From then on, it's very serious after the third offense. And I think them are the ones that I think we really need to do something with.

SENATOR HARTNETT: That's already in the statutes? We don't...

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: That's already in statute. Fourth offense DUI...

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...we don't have to do anything there?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: ...is a felony in this state.

SENATOR HARTNETT: We don't have to do anything there? Okay. Mr. Chairman, I would give the rest the time to Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you have about three and a half minutes.
