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the Legislature, there are people on the floor who have no sympathy for drunk drivers. There is so much complexity in this bill as it's presented that I don't think anybody understands all that's in it. I know I do not. I really don't, and I've tried to understand. It's not enough to say what a concept is that we're aiming for. We are dealing with crimes and punishments, and we ought to know what we are criminalizing, how we're criminalizing it, what we're punishing. And the ones who are to come under the reach of the law should clearly know by reading the law what it is they can and cannot do without falling into the clutches of the law. I don't believe the introducer knows everything in this bill. And it's not due to not having worked on it because he has worked on it. But try reading, when you get farther into the bill, where it cross-refers you to various sections of statute, and you read those sections and think you've got kind of a hold on it. Then you read further, and there is something farther along that might refer you back to that statute but the point from which you were referred is not quite the same as the first point from which you were referred when you were told to go to that statute. Then you will be referred to various sections in this bill. And when you read those sections to which you've been referred, you may be referred within those sections to other sections of statute. What you would have to do, in my opinion, is to print out all of those sections of statute to which you are referred, make at least two copies of the provisions in the bill to which you are referred. Then as you run into these cross-referrals, lay out under each one that to which you were referred. So if you're reading in Section 1 and it says go to Section 60-1, then you have a copy of 60-1 and you put that under which you are reading. Then as you read that, you got, okay, I'm under control when it comes to that. In the next section of the bill, it says go to Sections 20 and 21 of the bill. So you take Sections 20 and 21 and cut them out and put them under what you're reading here so you know what those sections are dealing with in connection with this that you've trying to understand. When you've clipped out Sections 20 and 21 and pasted them down and you read them, within Section 20, you are referred to other sections of the statute. So you go clip those too or also, and you continue to do that, and then at least you have before yourself all of the provisions that you're
