FLOOR DEBATE

March 28, 2003 LB 216

SENATOR BEUTLER: If you want to look at them, you can write the company and say, let me see the form that you're using in Nebraska, when they need it. Might as well not even have them file it. So, I won't belabor the point any further, but ask for your support on returning it for amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The motion before the Legislature is to return to Select File LB 216 for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: This is an important policy issue, Mr. President. I'd ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: We are on Final Reading, but we can ask for a check-in. Thank you, Senator Beutler. Would you all please check in. Would all members please return to the floor. Senator Tyson, Senator Kruse. We are awaiting the arrival of Senator Kruse. Senator Beutler has approved us to go ahead. For those who were not in the room, we are...the motion before the body is to return to Select File LB 216 for a specific amendment. Senator Beutler has asked for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1093.) 11 ayes, 22 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: The motion fails. We will go...please stay in your seats. We will go right into Final Reading for LB 216. Mr. Clerk, when you're ready. The first question is to dispense with the Final Reading. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with the at-large reading.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Yes, Senator Chambers.
