SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, I will try.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Kremer, I...these changes, are they because of federal regulations? Or is this from the Division of Weights and Measures?

SENATOR KREMER: No, they would not be from the Division of Weights and Measures. They would be pertaining to the Pure Food Act...

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay.

SENATOR KREMER: ...that was...that LB 250 was changes that brought us up-to-date to be in compliance with the Pure Food Code of 2001. And that...every so many years, we have to come up to be in compliance with the other states and be the same.

SENATOR JANSSEN: So what you're doing here is just complying with the new code that is set forth by the federal government,...

SENATOR KREMER: Yes, that...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...the national food...

SENATOR KREMER: ...that is true. And actually, what I'm doing here is just clarifying some technical changes. Want to refer back to some places that had been deleted and that no longer exist. So it had to be corrected. Really Revisor's corrections more than this. LB 220 (sic) itself was a little more complex than what just this is.
