counties, and more and more counties are becoming computerized. So what we're doing is just updating the statutes to correspond with the actual practice, and that is why I would hope that you would return this particular bill to Select File for this amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Seeing no lights on, Senator Hudkins, would you like to close? Senator Hudkins waives closing. The motion before the body is to return LB 292 to Select File for specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Would you record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: The bill is returned to Select File. Senator Hudkins, would you like to introduce the amendment?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. President and members. Hopefully, I have explained what the amendment does. It would just update the current statutes to reflect what is actually being done in the county treasurers' offices. Thank you.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Seeing no lights on, Senator Hudkins to close. Senator Hudkins waives closing. The motion is to accept the amendment to LB 292. All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, would you record, please.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: The amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, another amendment? I'm sorry. Senator Mossey.
